The Larry Garrett Concerto Competition is open to students enrolled in Youth Symphony for the Fall term. The competition will be held on Saturday, January 20, 2018 at Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Salem, 5090 Center St. NE, Salem.

You will have 10 minutes of actual playing time. You may use it to perform ample parts of your piece. Long introductions and transitions should be reduced by your accompanist to maximize the time you have to play.

The winner of the Larry Garrett Concerto Competition will play his/her performance piece with the Youth Symphony Orchestra at the Spring Concert. The Salem Youth Symphony Association does not guarantee that the final performance will include all of the movements you have prepared. Difficulty of the accompaniment may dictate the amount of music that can actually be performed. The conductor's decision is final.

The winner of the Larry Garrett Concerto Competition will receive a \$500 cash prize.

It is required that you perform with an accompanist. It will be your responsibility to arrange for and financially compensate an accompanist for the competition.

You must provide five photocopies of your concerto for the judges on January 20. Cuts should be marked.

The winner will be announced about thirty minutes after the last competitor has performed. It is not necessary to be present when the winner is announced; however, it is recommended.

Your financial account with SYSA must be current to participate in this event.
