Gentlemen: White long-sleeved collared dress shirt. Black bow tie. Black dress slacks.

Black closed-toed dress shoes with black socks.

Philharmonia

Ladies: All black. Tops must have sleeves. Long black dress, dress slacks to ankle or skirt mid-calf or longer with black dress blouse. Black hosiery and black closed-toed shoes.

Gentlemen: White long-sleeved collared dress shirt or tux shirt. Black bow tie. Black dress slacks.

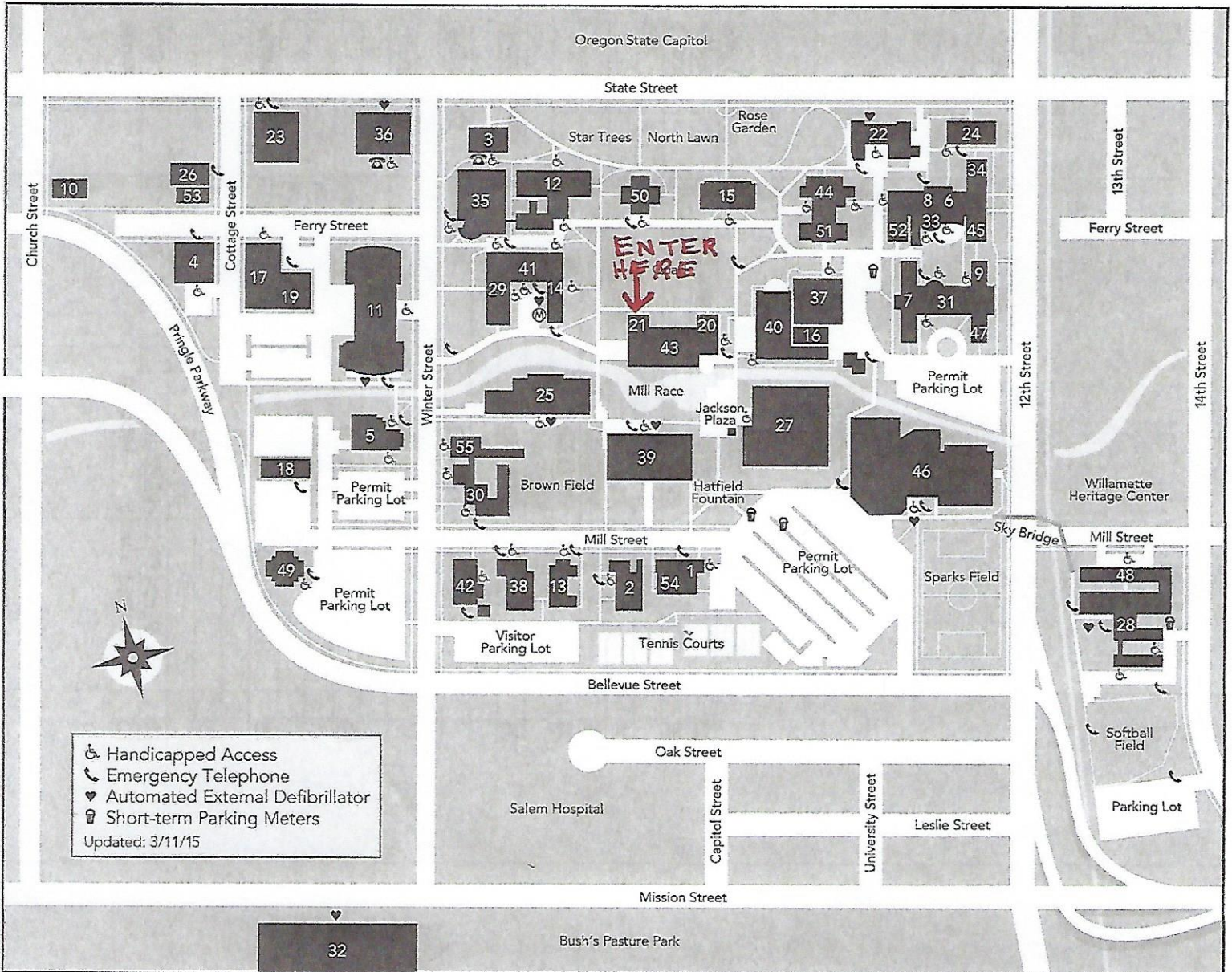
Black closed-toed dress shoes with black socks. Black jacket preferred or optional black vest.
